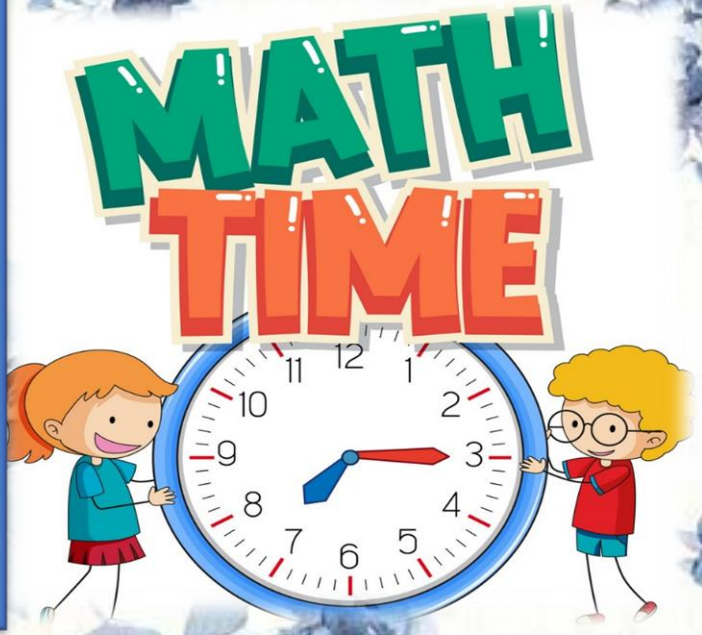


SCIENCE

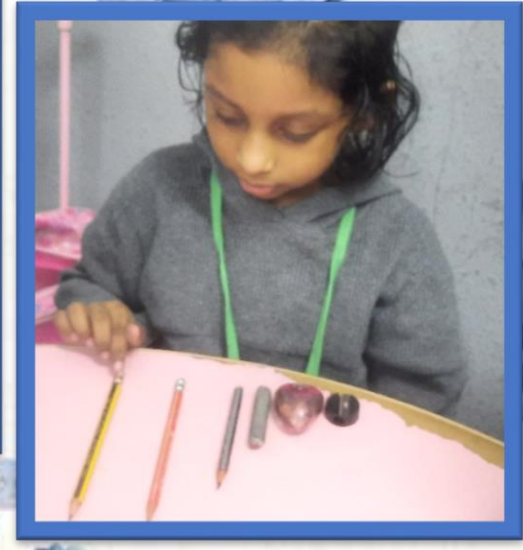

Early math is cognitively fundamental. It's not just about number and shapes. There's reasoning and thinking embedded in what we do in early mathematics that forms a foundation for years to come.

In the Month of December, children were introduced to the concept of one more and one less, number counting and sequencing.



LANGUAGE TIME

Children's language skills are connected to their overall development. As speaking and listening develops, they build foundation for literacy, for making sense of visual and verbal signs and ultimately for reading and writing.
